#### Master's vs. Law School

Earning a LLM degree BEFORE a JD:

- Law schools would look at your Master's GPA for admission, so this could be an opportunity to increase chances.
  - 15% of Columbia JD applicants had graduate coursework
- More professor connections for Personal Statement
- Greater independent projects can give you legal experience relevant to law schools

# **Working Alongside Your Degree**

- Set schedules for studying and doing readings
- Use assignment planners
- Ask for help when necessary
- Get adequate sleep when possible



- Set boundaries in relationships to prioritize schooling
- Ask co-workers to swap shifts during busy periods
- time management strategies are key

#### **FAQ**

- 1. How long does a Master's degree take?
  - a. Depending on course load (part-time or full-time), and the specific program,
     Master's degrees often take 1-3 years.
- 2. How much does a Master's degree cost?
  - a. Tuition fees for a Queen's master's degree for 2021-22 range from \$7,013-\$18,806 total depending on the program.
- 3. Am I guaranteed a salary bonus or greater job prospects with a Master's degree?
  - a. No; there is potential, but this is not always the case. For instance, engineers who already have high incomes on average often only see a **6%** salary increase. Average MBA lifetime earnings are **only 1%** greater than it would have been without their Master's degree.
